Careless handling of equipment Refusal to do as asked by members of staff Truanting lessons Leaving the classroom without permission | Repeat of B3 Failing to attend after school detentions More serious than B3 E.g. Fighting (in the playground) Vandalism /Chewing gum Behaviour likely to endanger others Misuse of phone/email or other electronic device Videoing/photographing others without consent Bullying including name calling causing distress to other students Dangerous behaviour on the school bus (& bus ban) Racist, sexist or homophobic remarks or actions Cheating in class assessment Theft Undermining staff authority Third incident with mobile phone Repeatedly refusing to do as asked by members of staff Swearing at other students |
