GL assessments	Literacy and Numeracy catch up testing	£415	Initial measure of students' starting point at KS3. This will be retested in the summer term to measure the progress made.
Accelerated Reader	Reading programme aimed at all abilities especially those on catch up Targeted pupils, in Years 7 with a score below 100 in Reading KS2 SATS, who have low levels of literacy receive extra lessons to accelerate their progress. Supporting this intervention programme is the Accelerated Reader Programme which seeks to instil in pupils a love of reading. This scheme is heavily promoted within school and is timetabled in conjunction with English lessons.	£3,000	Students on the programme have made progress as much as 6 months progress from the start of the programme in September to date.
TAs	Specifically targeted intervention for SEND pupils who have been part of the Catch up cohort. This has been used in a variety of ways including class based support to enable the specialist to work with the catch up students and also withdrawal lessons to aid deeper thinking and pace.	£32,747	SEND students are making progress in line with their expectation – evidence DD3 2018
