Re: Ofsted Monitoring visit: December 2019

We were visited by HMI Ofsted on 10th/11th December 2019 for a no notice Section 8 Ofsted Safeguarding inspection.

The inspection took place due to concerns raised about our Safeguarding arrangements. I am pleased to confirm that following the two day visit, the Inspectors concluded that Safeguarding **was effective** at Khalsa Academy Wolverhampton and Leaders of the school ensure that all processes are followed rigorously. I have summarised below key points raised throughout the two day visit:

- “Pupils are safe at the academy. This is because you and other senior leaders have ensured that safeguarding procedures are robust.”
- “It was clear that you and other leaders had responded effectively to concerns raised. Where appropriate, you have strengthened practice as a result of lessons learned”
- “Staff know when pupils need help and what to do about it”
- Pupils say that they feel safe and that they know how to keep themselves safe, particularly online..”
- “Information about pupil’s attendance and behaviour is analysed well to build a comprehensive picture around each child.”
- “They provide preventative support for all pupils or individuals, where necessary.”
- “Staff work closely with external agencies to ensure that pupils are safe.”
- “The new Chair of the local governing board understands safeguarding well..”
- “Academy leaders have ensured that safeguarding practice is the academy is strong.”

The inspectors visited lessons, spoke to staff and pupils during their two day visit. They were positive about behaviour, staffing, and our inclusion provision. Meetings were also held with the Senior Leadership team, Pastoral team and Curriculum Leaders to ensure consistency of systems and procedures in the school. There was recommendations for improvements in how the Trust monitors safeguarding practices at the school which will be actioned.
