Please can I begin by thanking you for your support these first two weeks? The students and staff have been fabulous and we are dealing with any initial teething problems that we have had. Please find below some updates:

1 Enrichment

We look forward to enrichment starting next week. Students will be finishing school at 4.05pm from Monday-Thursdays. Please can I request that if your son/daughter has opted for an activity where payment is required that this is made on time? Enrichment will run initially for 6 weeks up until Friday 3rd November but I may be extending past this date depending on the review that we will be undertaking to see how well it is doing. It is compulsory for all students but I will also be writing to you shortly for consultation on how we continue with enrichment going forward.

2 Revised transport timetable for students who use the school buses

Given that we are starting enrichment next week and having done a review of current transport timings we are amending our pick-up and drop-off times from next Monday, 18th September. (See attached).
