Re: Educational provision following National lockdown

Dear parents/carers,

I am writing to you to provide you with a further update following the Government's announcement yesterday. After meeting with my Senior Leadership Team and the Trust, the arrangements until February half term are as follows:

New plans:

All pupils will revert to remote learning until February half term with immediate effect from today Tuesday 5th January. This will be a mixture of live lessons and pre-recorded/ Powerpoint and assignments via our online platform google classrooms. Our remote learning provision is strong, however If your child needs any support or has any issues with remote learning please email us at googlesupport@tkaw.org

If your child is having issues with accessing remote learning please let us know so that we can arrange learning packs to be sent out to your child.

We will also have provision for pupils whose parents are critical workers as well as provision for vulnerable and pupils with EHCPs.

Please fill out as a matter of urgency, the form below, if you would like your child to attend provision from Wednesday 6th January until Friday 15th January. We will then resend the link for the following weeks.

Please note that it is extremely important that we have this information so that we can allocate staffing. Any parent that has filled out the information previously will need to re submit the form above. Apologies for the inconvenience this may have.

Timetable/Form time/safeguarding:

We will continue to run our normal school day timetable over two weeks. Staff, as mentioned above will provide a mixture of live lessons and pre-recorded/ powerpoints and assignments. This is so that we can ensure we do not miss out on key learning and reduce our curriculum offer.

This will be two pre-recorded form time sessions over the fortnight as well as pupils receiving a phone call over the fortnight. This is so that we can check in with your child and address any issues that they may have been having.

Exams: (Years 11 & 12)

Years 11 and 12 **vocational exams will still go ahead during the next few weeks**. We have outlined online revision sessions and on site attendance as below:

Year 12 Vocational Business group ONLY:

ALL year 12 BTEC Business Vocational students are required to attend the online drop down day **on Tuesday 5th January 2021 for exam preparations from 8.45am-3.05pm**. Please visit your **Google classroom for the link**. On the following day, **Wednesday 6th January ALL BTEC business students are required to arrive on site by 8.30am ready to sit the BTEC Business vocational exam from 9.00am-12.00pm**, after the exam students will be escorted off site and Period 5 lessons will commence as normal (remote).

Year 11 PE (options) Group ONLY:

On Friday 8th January the PE (options) pupils are required to attend the online drop down day, **for exam preparations from 8.45am-3.05pm**. Please visit your **Google classroom for the link**. On **Monday 11th January ALL PE Options pupils are required to arrive on site by 8.30am ready to sit their exam at 9.00am-10.00pm**, after the exam students will be escorted off site and Period 5 lessons will commence as normal (remote).

Year 12 Digital Media group ONLY:

On Friday 15th January **ALL Digital Media students (year 12) are required to arrive on site by 9.00 am for a revision session, ready to sit their exam in the afternoon**. After the exam, students will be escorted off site

Intervention:

All after school interventions are cancelled until February half term. Mr Singh will send out more information next week regarding intervention online.

Testing:

As you may be aware, the government have asked schools to set up Mass Testing (Lateral Flow Tests). We are in the process of working with the LA and Trust, in setting up our test centre that will be in use for our pupils and staff only. I will be sending out Consent forms out this week, which will need to be return via our online forms (especially those accessing school provision during lockdown). We will send out a letter regarding testing later this week.

Again I would like to thank you all for your patience and understanding during this difficult time. Know that we are here to help and that we are one school family. If you need anything please do not hesitate to speak to us as we will always do what we can. I will keep in touch with you via emails/ letters/ social media so that we can share information and guidance with you.
