RE: Year 6 Induction - The Khalsa Academy Wolverhampton

We are delighted to confirm that your child will be joining us at The Khalsa Academy Wolverhampton from September 2020 and we look forward to you joining the TKAW family.

As part of our induction process, all parents are invited to attend an online parental evening on **Thursday 25th June at 6pm**. To access the event parents will simply need to visit the TKAW website and follow the live stream. We strongly recommend you access the website a little earlier than 6pm so that you do not miss any vital information. During the event, parents will be able to ask any questions via a live comments box, we will then endeavour to answer all queries.

Due to the current health situation, this year, our Year 6 transition day will differ from previous years. All students are invited to attend **one** of four transition days commencing **Monday 29th June up to and including Thursday 2nd July**. 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*** Timings for the Transition Days - 9.30am – 9.55am staggered arrival with a 10am start. Lessons will finish at 1pm. 1:05pm – 1:30pm staggered collection of students. The timings of the days allow for the safe arrival and departure of students. ***

Students will need to bring their completed blue admission pack with them on their transition day.

During the transition day, students will meet key members of staff and will have an opportunity to sample life at a secondary school. Students will also receive a copy of the book "Wonder", their transition work packs and their log in details to be able to access their very own online Google classroom. In the Google classroom, they will be able to access engaging tasks and activities from each subject to complete over the summer.

Students who are unable to attend their transition day will receive their transition pack by post.

TKAW COVID-19 Safety Measures – Year 6 Parents/Students

The health and safety of our students is our priority and with this in mind, we have worked hard to ensure the site is prepared and precautions have been taken.

The following measures will take effect when students are on site;

- Parents will drive to the staff car park at the rear of the school where a member of staff will greet them.
- Students will have their temperatures taken whilst still seated in cars.
- Any students that have symptoms or a temperature over 38 degrees will not be allowed on site.
- The current symptoms are;
- **high temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
- If your child or anybody in your household is displaying any of these symptoms, please do not send them into school and please inform their primary school and us.
- Students will follow a clearly marked and labelled one-way system.
- Once students have entered the building, they will be required to wash their hands thoroughly.
- If they wish, students may bring a sandwich and a bottle of water in a disposable bag. No school/lunch bags will be allowed onsite.
- Students will not need to bring a pencil case or any equipment to school, **except for a single pen** that they must not share with anybody.

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- Students will have access to toilet facilities, which have been cordoned off, to allow for social distancing.
- Students are **not** required to wear uniform and where possible should ensure the clothing they have worn that day has been washed.
- PE/Sports kits are not required. No physical activities will take part on the transition days.
- Hand sanitisers have been placed in each classroom and at each entry and exit point in the building. Students will be encouraged to use these throughout the period of time they are on site.

We hope the measures outlined demonstrate our commitment to ensuring that our students are as safe as possible during this time.

On the TKAW website, you will find a Year 6 Transition page with; a video showing the drop off procedure for the transition days, support materials for accessing Google classroom and other key sources of information.
